Good evening,

Yeovil Town, second in the table but out of the championship race, will provide a stiff test for us but a repeat of Saturdays form could well see two more points being added to our best ever total in the Southern Leagues Premier Division.

Down at the Huish ground a couple of months ago Yeovil beat us 2-0 and past records show that they have taken considerably more points out of the meetings home and away than we have but in a season when we have surprised a good many sides they too will have to be on their guard.

On Monday we made the long trip to Maidstone, the last away match of the season, and came back pointless on the wrong end of a 3-0 scoreline but overall this season our away form has been tremendous.

Twenty points have been taken on foreign soil, almost an average of a point a game and in the process first ever victories at Barnet and Guildford have been highlights - at the start of the season our aim was to consolidate in the Premier Division having just won promotion - this has been done and we can look to next season with even more confidence.

Tonight is something of a special night for both supporters and players for apart from a very attractive game there is the added interest of the Player of the Year award presentation to be made by Mrs. Vera Goode immediately after the final whistle in front of the main stand.

Also tonight the new Social Club is open to the public for the first time - on behalf of the management committee of Burton Albion Supporters Club I would like to thank Ron Jones and Pat Mooney and their ever willing band of voluntary helpers for the tremendous job they have done on the building.

A long standing gap has now been filled - it is up to the supporters now to make it into the success we all hope for if extra cash is to be made available to the Football Club for future improvements.
