

# Manager Profile

**BRIAN HALL:** 45 year old Brian was born in Ealing, Middlesex and was reared on Brentford FC watching them from the age of nine. He went on to play for the Metropolitan Police from 1963 to 1968 in the Greater London League and Metropolitan League. Brian later played for Dunstable and in 1973 obtained his first full coaching badge at Loughborough College. In that same year, he joined Walton & Hersham and it was there he met the man who made a big impression on his future - Alan Batsford. They both moved to Wimbledon, Batsford as Manager and Hall as his assistant and coach. It was there the fairy tale came true when Wimbledon were elected to the Football League. After 18 months coaching at Slough, he moved to Wycombe in 1970. In 1980, Brian got together again with Batsford at Wealdstone and although they were relegated at the end of their first season from the Alliance, they bounced straight back from the Southern League the next year. In 1983, Brian took charge at Wealdstone and in 1984/5 they won the Gola League, FA Trophy, Middlesex Senior Cup and the Capital League Cup. In January 1987, Brian was appointed Manager at Haish and within 15 months he had won the Vauxhall-Opel League Championship and AG Delco Cup. With the League triumph, came the coveted promotion spot back into the GVA Vauxhall Conference, after an absence of three years.
